

MANNFIELD CEMETERY

T 19S - R 20E - S 18

Location: Cemetery site is located on east side of Highway 491 in mid-western portion of the Withlacoochee State Forest, Citrus County Florida.

Period of Significance: 1887 – 1891

Mannfield was the first county seat location which was determined by the State Legislature in 1887, when Citrus County was established. In 1891, the county seat was re-located permanently to Inverness. By 1895, the Mannfield community had dwindled to no population other nearby settlements were established.
