Location: Cemetery site is located 100 feet south of Trail 10, Withlacoochee State Forest, .8 miles south of CR 581, Citrus County Florida.

Period of Significance: Phosphate Mining Era 1890 - 1912

A pioneer settlement of the Phosphate Mining Era of the late 19th century. When WWI began, phosphate ore was no longer mined and the community was abandoned.
